The Hylands Horses Project is a partnership between Chelmsford Borough Council and Hawthorn Heavy Horses to return working horses to the Hylands Estate. Located on the outskirts of Chelmsford, Essex, Hylands House and the newly opened Stables Centre is a stunning heritage venue set in 574 acres of Grade II* listed parkland.

Using rare breed Suffolk Punch horses, we support the management of the Hylands Estate by providing environmentally sensitive management and visitor attractions, including carriage rides, grass cutting, harrowing, timber extraction and heavy horse related educational talks.

The horses can usually be seen out grazing on the Hylands Estate when not fulfilling the work on the schedule overleaf.

Hylands Firewood Logs – Are available to buy from the Stables Visitor Centre Shop. This is a very special product exclusive to Hylands. Hawthorn Heavy Horses and the Hylands conservation volunteers coppice the woodlands at Hylands. Holly, one of Hylands Suffolk punches, then extracts the wood, which is then seasoned, processed and bagged on site. Therefore it is very environmentally sensitive as there is no long distance transportation involved. It is also very good value at just **£3 a bag**.
